

FLAGS

GREEN = Go start the race.

YELLOW = Caution (slow down, problem on the track).

RED = stop (but do'nt slam on your brakes)

BLUE & YELLOW = courtesy (move to the top of the track & let the cars pass you).

WHITE = One lap left in the race .

BLACK = If given to you rolled up it's a warning that your doing something wrong.

If given to you not rolled up, take your car to the pits NOW!!!

WHITE & GREEN = Crossed means the race is at halfway .

RED & YELLOW = Restart where you first lined up from the first of the race.

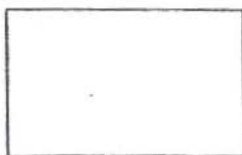
(commonly given if a wreck happens before one lap is complete).

CHECKERED = Finish (this race is over).

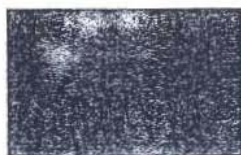

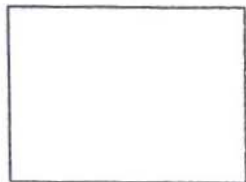

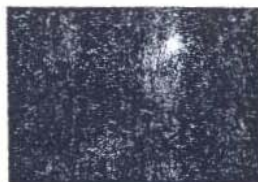

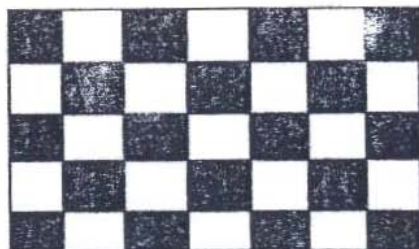

ONE LAP LEFT



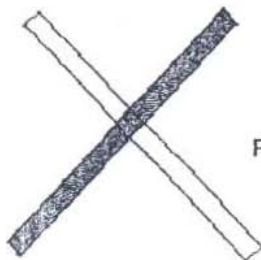
OUT OF RACE / GO TO PITS

General Rules

1. Speed Limit 5 mph
2. **5 pound** fire extinguisher in your pit and visible
3. **2 ½ pound** extinguisher or fire suppression system on board all cars, in reach of driver.
4. **ALL** roll bars within reach of head, arms, legs. Must have roll bar padding on them.
5. Driver side deflector plates to fill openings between door bars **Highly Recommended**.
Minimum 1/8 inch steel suggested.
6. Adequate foot protection - **Mandatory** foot bars, etc.
7. SFI approved 3 inch variety - 5 point seat belts, **Mandatory** mounting and dates - subject to track approval.
8. Gloves, shoes, neck braces, and fire resistant suit **Mandatory**.
9. Radio Communication devices **WILL NOT** be allowed at the Race Track for driver to pit communication.
10. **Track Race Procedures**, such as Qualifying, Heats, Trophy Dashes and Mains, are subject to change and may be different from race to race.
11. A **3 minute hold** may be requested by **Driver or Pit Personnel** prior to a race start. If so, the **Driver requesting the hold will automatically start in Rear of His Event**.
